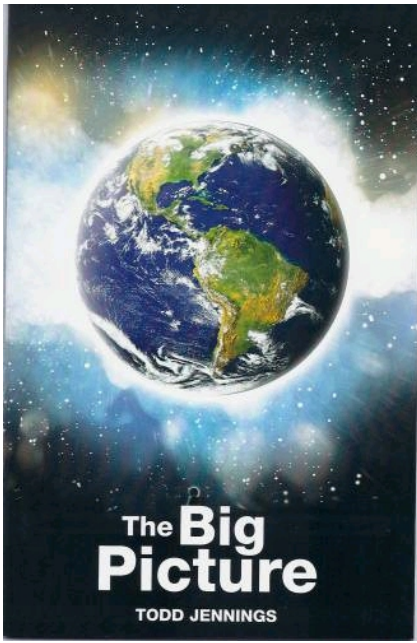

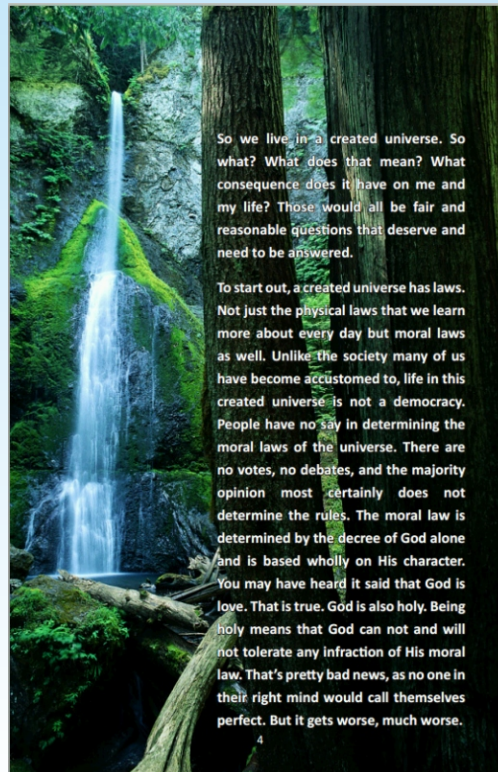

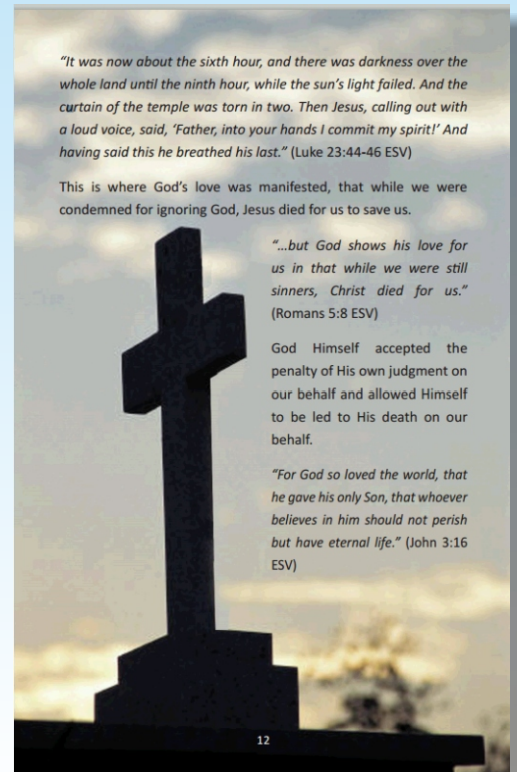

So we live in a created universe. So what? What does that mean? What consequence does it have on me and my life? Those would all be fair and reasonable questions that deserve and need to be answered.

To start out, a created universe has laws. Not just the physical laws that we learn more about every day but moral laws as well. Unlike the society many of us have become accustomed to, life in this created universe is not a democracy. People have no say in determining the moral laws of the universe. There are no votes, no debates, and the majority opinion most certainly does not determine the rules. The moral law is determined by the decree of God alone and is based wholly on His character. You may have heard it said that God is love. That is true. God is also holy. Being holy means that God can not and will not tolerate any infraction of His moral law. That's pretty bad news, as no one in their right mind would call themselves perfect. But it gets worse, much worse.



"It was now about the sixth hour, and there was darkness over the whole land until the ninth hour, while the sun's light failed. And the curtain of the temple was torn in two. Then Jesus, calling out with a loud voice, said, 'Father, into your hands I commit my spirit!' And having said this he breathed his last." (Luke 23:44-46 ESV)
