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## About the Cover

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**S**o, why the peacock feather on the cover? Because Charles Darwin hated it. He wrote, “The sight of a feather in a peacock’s tail, whenever I gaze at it, makes me sick!”<sup>1</sup>

The obvious problem was that he did not know how to plausibly explain this large, mathematically patterned, jewel-colored, gratuitous display of beauty in evolutionary terms. A peacock tail can stand five feet high. And all those cumbersome feathers are most inconvenient regarding the chief survival-of-the-fittest issue—namely, not being eaten. This was no small dilemma for Mr. Darwin.

In keeping with his general approach to science, Darwin concocted a story. Give the man credit. He knew how to weave a nar-

rative. This is, of course, the foremost skill of his disciples. Story-telling is far less bothersome than engaging in the exacting rigors of real science.

Darwin proposed a theory of sexual selection. That is, peahens prefer peacocks with the best tails. Best meaning, the biggest and most colorful. The gaudier the tail, Darwin surmised, the better the peacock would fare with the peahens, and consequently pass on more of the flamboyant plumage genes to male offspring.

Oops. Yeah, this doesn't actually happen. This is where story-telling, as opposed to truly doing science, puts one in a bit of a bind. A "seven-year study that observed 268 matings"<sup>2</sup> conducted by scientists *seeking to confirm* Darwin's theory, found that peacock sexual selection based upon the coolest tail, is, and sorry, I couldn't resist borrowing Ph.D. David Catchpoole's quote, "poppycock."<sup>3</sup>

The "tail tale"<sup>4</sup> is the perfect parable of Darwinian evolutionary theory. It's all just unsubstantiated anecdotes. Regarding the macro-Darwinian hypothesis, there is no hard data. Zero. But oh, what a fanciful myth of unparalleled imagination has been fabricated for the incurious and unwary!

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# Introduction

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“. . . Holy, Holy, Holy, is the LORD of hosts,  
The whole earth is full of His glory.”

*Isaiah 6:3*

David is watching a thunderstorm pass through Lebanon, and worship is rising in his heart and mind. It's the thinking person's instinctive response to the genius, power, complexity, symmetry, beauty, design, and scale revealed in the created order. David's praise is recorded in Psalm 29:

Ascribe to the LORD glory and strength. Ascribe to the LORD the glory due to His name. . . . The God of glory thunders. . . . The voice of the LORD is powerful. The voice of the LORD is majestic. The voice of the LORD breaks the cedars. . . . The voice of the LORD hews out flames of fire. The voice of the LORD shakes the wilderness. . . . Everything says, "Glory!"<sup>1</sup>

David sees it. He feels it. He knows it. It's unmistakable. There's glory. There's wonder. There's awe. There is a deep, visceral awareness of the Transcendent. His soul is shouting, "God!" Not just any god, but a Creator-God of unsearchable greatness,<sup>2</sup> before whom the earth trembles and the mountains melt like wax.<sup>3</sup>

David recognizes what C.S. Lewis calls the "divine, magical, terrifying, and ecstatic reality in which we all live."<sup>4</sup> The created order demands the God hypothesis. He cannot not be there. Lest this overwhelming intuition of glory be willfully and proactively "suppressed,"<sup>5</sup> worship is the only reasonable response afforded to humanity. The intellectually honest person must and will stand in utter amazement!

It's David's response. He is filled with wonderment, as well he should be, at the Author of such a magnificent display of power. But, in one sense, it's only *just* a thunderstorm. You and I

have so much more insight into the ubiquitous and inestimable power resident within the known universe.

### **The Hiding of His Power**

You and I have seen the pictures from the Hubble Space Telescope. We have peered 13+ billion light years into the “deep space field.”<sup>6</sup> We know that one present estimate of galaxies—not stars, or planets, but galaxies—in the known cosmos is 2 trillion!<sup>7</sup> We also know that our sun is a gigantic fusion reactor with a core temperature of 27 million degrees Fahrenheit and that about one million earths could fit inside of it. We know, too, that UY Scuti, the largest known star, has a volume 5 billion times that of our sun! The mind boggles at the sheer, unquantifiable enormity of energy pulsating throughout the natural realm. And this seemingly endless, even redundant, display of might is, as God’s prophet writes, the “hiding of His power.”<sup>8</sup> Yeah, David got it right: “Glory!”

### **The Creator’s Intellectual Property**

David was not only astonished at what he saw. He was amazed at what he was. He understood he was “fearfully and wonderfully made.”<sup>9</sup> I’ve always loved how David finished that thought. He wrote, “wonderful are Your works, and my soul knows it very well.”<sup>10</sup> The knowing changes everything, doesn’t it? We have no doubt. We have no “excuse.”<sup>11</sup> We know, “It is He who has made us and not we ourselves.”<sup>12</sup> Consequently, we comprehend that we are not cosmic free agents. We are, in the very least, whether we know and love Him or not, an awesome Creator’s intellectual property.

David is marveling, as well he should, at the Designer of such a being as he. But by twenty-first century standards, David knows next to nothing of the unfathomable miracle that is the human body. It is estimated to take about “60 zettabytes (60 with 21 zeros after) of information”<sup>13</sup> to build a human being. Within the DNA in each one of the estimated 40-100 trillion cells in your

body (except red blood cells), are 3.5 billion characters of information; the instructions for building you. Yes, that's a lot! So where did all that code come from? A good guess would be, not from nothing, and not by chance.

David, who didn't know a fraction of what you and I know, knew this. He was a great deal more than mere chemistry and biology. And no matter how adamantly modern academia and the media tell us we are little more than grown-up germs, we intuitively know it's a lie. We know there is something more, something bigger, something meaningful, something beautiful, something magnificent . . . Someone glorious! We know there is something more awe-inspiring than the net effect of a long chain of chemical reactions, random variation, and natural selection. Biological and cognitive realities, rational deliberation, logical deduction, and commonsense will not allow the thinking person to embrace materialistic reductionism.

### **Bumping into Wonder**

Naturalism and materialism (the philosophy that nothing exists except matter and its movements and modifications) simply can't explain what each of us feels as we drink in the wonder we bump into every single day of our lives. We wake up to a conscious mind brimming with feelings, hopes, dreams, and creative instincts. If we're paying any attention at all, we intuit the Divine at every turn and, indeed, feel the impulse to bow down. We kiss our soul mate and taste the passionate rush of deep romance, love, and intimacy. We hear Beethoven's Ninth Symphony and know our souls were designed to soar with joy. We watch a perfect moonrise and a breathtaking sunset, and we know we're made to not only recognize, but savor majestic beauty. We look into the Milky Way on a clear night and we sense that infinity awaits. Yes, David is right every single day in every single circumstance: "Everything says, 'Glory!'"

Satan hates this. It's why he and his minions have expended so much pseudo-intellectual capital in seeking to discredit the

Genesis creation account. If the words “In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth”<sup>14</sup> are true, we have a Creator before whom we are accountable with all the obvious implications extending into a timeless eternity. If Genesis 1:1 is not true, not much else really matters. Mankind is an inexplicable, meaningless, pathetic, doomed, cosmic accident; all dressed up with nowhere to go. Satan knows what’s at stake in the first two chapters of Genesis. Ultimately, everything is a divinely wrought miracle, or nothing is. The adversary desperately wants you to buy into the latter. He wants to steal the glory you and I were created to see, taste, savor, enjoy, and inherit!

### **The Radically God-Centered Point of Creation**

Christian, our testimony is that the created order is the miraculous handiwork of a breathtakingly awesome God. The apostle Paul writes, “For by Him [Jesus Christ] all things were created, both in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible . . . all things have been created through Him and for Him.<sup>15</sup> Understand, everything is not only *from* Him; everything is *for* Him, and, of course, everything is *about* Him! Yes, that is the radically God-centered, bottom-line message of Creation and the gospel. Jesus Christ is the point! He’s always been the point! He will always be the point!

It’s why the Genesis creation account matters. It’s why it matters a lot. It’s why it’s non-negotiable for the “born-again”<sup>16</sup> Bible believer. This is all about Jesus Christ. That’s why the Genesis account is relentlessly attacked in the world. Because it’s all about the glory of the Son of Man. And, as every born-again soul knows and understands, the world “hates”<sup>17</sup> the biblical Jesus. The world is always working if not to mythologize the God-Man, then, in the very least, to marginalize Him. The world doesn’t mind so much if it can relegate Him to the status of religious icon. But He is never, under any circumstance, to be acknowledged as the supernatural, personal, eternal, omnipotent, omniscient, galaxy-breathing, life-giving, cosmos-upholding-and-sustaining Creator-God!

## **Nonsense Is Nonsense**

The adherents of scientism (the view that science is the only way to truth) tell us that God is an unnecessary and unwarranted presupposition. They tell us that stuff just happens. You know, sometimes there's nothing, and then, unaccountably, there's everything! Yeah, I know. But it's actually what this secular religion asserts. Arguably the most famous scientist of the modern era, Stephen Hawking, wrote. . .

because there is a law such as gravity, the universe will create itself from nothing. . . . Spontaneous creation is the reason there is something rather than nothing, why the universe exists, why we exist. It is not necessary to invoke God to . . . set the universe going.<sup>18</sup>

I know; a self-creating universe. And not just your run-of-the-mill universe, mind you—but a seemingly infinite space-time-matter-energy-information-intelligence universe replete with mystifying intricacy, regularity, equilibrium, order, elegance, beauty, and precision fine-tuning. You're right: it's a perfect rabbit out of a hat. Oh, without the rabbit. And oh, without the hat. And yes, of course, without a Magician. Oxford math professor John Lennox sums up this attempt to yank a universe out of nothing better than anyone: “. . .nonsense remains nonsense, even when talked by world-famous scientists.”<sup>19</sup>

## **Darwin's Pseudo-Science**

This brings me to Charles Darwin, the nineteenth-century English naturalist who is known as the father of the “particles to people”<sup>20</sup> evolutionary hypothesis. It is not my assertion that Charles Darwin and others were, or are, consciously waging war on Jesus Christ. It may be true. It may well not be true. But that is ultimately beside the point. This book is not about Darwin's theology; it's about his science. And his science has proven to be little more than anecdotal observation, exaggerated inference,



unsophisticated speculation, and just some good old-fashioned storytelling.

Obviously, Darwin was keenly aware of the substantial empirical problems his theory was running into early on. As science has progressed into the twenty-first century, those difficulties have only multiplied . . . exponentially. They are, in fact, insurmountable. In my reading, I have seen more than one scientist question whether Darwin, given the current avalanche of evidence against his thesis, would continue to hold to it.

Macro-Darwinian evolution is dead. It doesn't work. It was pseudo-science in the nineteenth century and it has only gotten uglier. It's not science at all. It's a philosophical worldview through which data is interpreted. It is certainly more akin to religion than to science. There are no facts proving macroevolution. Zero. Nada. They do not exist. Not one single, solitary, indisputable fact corroborates the fantastic efficacy attributed to biological evolution. So, you may ask, why do people believe it? The simple answer is this: because they want to. They want to believe it. So, they see it. It's the classic example of a conclusion in search of evidence.

### **Science Done Right Points to God**

I know the world gets mad at Bible-believing Christians about this. I know they get red-faced about it. I know they think we're knuckle-dragging fundamentalists. I know they call us ignorant rubes and science-deniers. But the truth of the matter is this: we have the science! We have the data! Darwinists concoct fanciful stories out of thin air, while creationists deal with hard facts. Cambridge Ph.D. Stephen C. Meyer said it perfectly: "Science done right points to God."<sup>21</sup>

Unfortunately, this is news to some readers—that we, as Christians, not only hold the only credible theological explanation for a glory-infused cosmos, but that we, indeed, hold the only plausible scientific explanation. It's my sense that many readers don't know that is true. It's why I've labored outside my

field in preparing this book. I'm an evangelical, Bible-believing preacher but I did not write this book to make the theological argument for a Creator. I wrote this book to enlighten you about brilliant scientists who are making the empirical argument for Him. These men and women get it. They see Him in the data. It screams at them from their microscopes and their telescopes: "Everything says, 'Glory!'"

### **Why Read This Book?**

So why read a book mostly about evolution written by a really, really smalltime preacher? I would humbly suggest two reasons.

*One*, science is not some mystical, ethereal realm that only the lab-coated priesthood of scientism can understand. I know they like to project and preserve that illusion, but it's not true. Everyone, to one degree or another, is a scientist. We observe and we learn. Science can be accurately defined simply as "Knowledge . . . gained through experience."<sup>22</sup> That's really all there is to it. It's what Cambridge Ph.D. Douglas Axe calls "common science." Axe writes, ". . . mastery of technical subjects isn't at all needed in order for us to know the answer to the big question."<sup>23</sup> He's right.

*Secondly*, I am only relaying information I've gleaned from broad reading on the topic. There are many excellent books that expose macroevolutionary science for what it is—a feeble, fanciful, and uninteresting creation myth. But most of those volumes are 200+ pages that sometimes get into the technical weeds. Most Christians simply will not take the time to read these works. I pray my service to the reader is to simply and succinctly pass on what eminent scientists are now saying and which clearly debunks the Darwinian folklore that pollutes our culture.

### **The Payoff in Reading This Book**

As already stated, this book is not about what I think; it's about what scientists know—brilliant, erudite, competent, degreed men and women who are diligently and painstakingly seeking truth and, consequently, discovering and documenting the

heartfelt sentiments of David in Psalm 29. I will quote these men and women liberally throughout the book. It's the payoff for you in reading this work. What are real scientists and thinkers saying about the materialistic, Darwinian paradigm? Here is a small sampling. . .
